On behalf of the Friends of the LSU Textile & Costume Museum, I extend a personal invitation to you to become a member of the Friends of the Museum for the 2014-2015 academic year. The Friends Annual Membership Meeting and Luncheon, held September 12<sup>th</sup> at the Governor's Mansion, was an exciting beginning to this past membership year. For the first time, a very special exhibition of the Museum's *First Families of Louisiana Collection* included the Jindal family's inaugural apparel!

In the Museum's gallery, the exhibition *In the Couture Tradition: The Gowns of Suzanne Perron*, opened in November and featured the special occasion gowns of the New Orleans couture designer and LSU alumna. Programming included a campus-held workshop in couture techniques conducted by Perron and her studio for the school's apparel design students. Its replacement, *Knot Just Beads: Works by Bead/Fiber Artist Jane Olson-Phillips*, included over 100 works by the local Baton Rouge resident as well as antique and vintage jewelry donated to the Museum by the artist. *Hemline@LSU: Students Promoting Fashion and Philanthropy* was mounted this summer and highlights the student organization's participation in the American Heart Association's *Go Red For Hearts* campaign and the group's production of its annual runway show and student design competition. Artifacts from the Museum's collections were also part of other area exhibitions this last year, including two at West Baton Rouge Museum, *A Louisianan's Grand Tour in the Belle Époque* and *100 Years after the War to End All Wars: 1914-2014*.

It has been a busy year for the Friends, too. Not only was the 2013 "Your Friends' Closet Sale" a success but also the third annual *Tea, Fashion & Fancies* fundraiser held in partnership with LSU Rural Life Museum in February. Now, it is almost time for our ninth "Your Friends' Closet Sale" on Saturday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, at the LSU Mini-Farm! Sale donations continue to be accepted at Friends' Sale partner Mignon Faget during its retail store hours at Town Center.
